As the calendar turns over to another year, most people start thinking about what they did or didn't do the past year, and what they would like for the new year to bring. Some people make resolutions or goals, others might just spend some time in prayer-ful meditation. Whatever your personal new year habits might be, the Bible is the best source for guidance and wisdom. Here are some verses that can help you get started with the new year – or with any new beginning in your life.

Isaiah 60:20 (ESV) "Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; for the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your days of mourning shall be ended." The entire chapter of Isaiah 60 to me is about new beginnings and making the new better than the old. I picked this particular verse, though, because of the emphasis on the Lord as our light and an end to days of mourning. Whether you're wanting to move past a year that was filled with tragedy or hardship, or you just want this coming year to be better than the last one, every verse of Isaiah 60 speaks to promotion and new beginnings

Revelation 21:5 (ESV) "And he who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new."

God makes everything new. This simple thought is one of the most profound, and can carry you through any change: God is always on the throne, and He is always making all things new.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."

This verse reminds us that if we believe that Jesus is the Son of God and died for our sins, then we are no longer what we once were. It's true that bad things happen even to believers, and we all still make mistakes – but we don't have to live with the permanent spiritual consequences of those things. Jesus has made all things new for us.

Sometimes a new year or a new beginning may not arrive with feelings of joy or excitement. But we know we can come to God with any need, and we will receive His help. If you're facing a difficult decision or an uncomfortable transition, come boldly to God's throne and receive His grace and love. HEBREWS 4:16 "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

Sunday, January 22, 2017 / Following Worship Snow date : January 29, 2017.


We are looking forward to **ALL** who can attend this meeting. You do not have to be a member to attend so please stay



Louis Richard Batzler

Louis Richard Batzler, 94, who served churches in Frederick County from 1971 to 1983, died Tuesday, Nov. 29, at his home in Kill Devil Hills, N.C. Born Sept. 27, 1922, in Baltimore, he was a son of the late John F. and Ruth Coblentz Batzler.

He was the husband of Evelyn M. Greisz, who died April 28, 2010. They were married 63 years.

He studied at Franklin and Marshall College, Lancaster, Pa., and received a bachelor of philosophy from Loyola College, Baltimore, and a master of arts and Ph.D. in history from Georgetown University.

In 1960, he graduated from Lancaster Theological Seminary, and was ordained as a minister in the United Church of Christ, where he served congregations in Maryland, Pennsylvania, Ohio and North Carolina.

He was an exchange pastor in New Orleans and Kilmarnock, Scotland.

His ministry included college, hospital and hospice chaplainships, and leadership positions in ecumenical and interfaith orga-

nizations.

As an educator, he taught in a Baltimore public school, in five colleges, youth camps, a holistic health center and a national counseling organization.

He was a Navy hospital corpsman during World War II, a CIA intelligence officer and was a candidate for U.S. House in Ohio's Fifth District.

Survivors include a sister, Anne E. Naff, of Middletown; daughter, Margaret A. Khoury of Las Vegas, Nev.; sons Louis R. Batzler Jr., of Kill Devil Hills, N.C., and Lloyd Batzler, of Rockville; grandson, Richard J. Batzler, of Washington, D.C., granddaughter, Katherine D. Batzler, of Rockville; and a number of nieces and nephews.

He was a brother of the late John F. "Jack" Batzler Jr., Lloyd C. Batzler and Ruth C. Naff.

A memorial service is Jan. 7 at Outer Banks Presbyterian Church, Kill Devil Hills.

A graveside service will be at Faith Church, Frederick, at a later date. There is a wall in the Fireside Lounge with 5x7's of the past history of our pastors including Reverend Batzler's.

We will be adding to our wall as our Faith pastors continue.
