JIESUIS CUIRSIES A IFIG TIREE BIIBLE STORY

12 The next day as they were leaving Bethany, Jesus was hungry.
13 Seeing in the distance a fig tree in leaf, he went to find out if it had any fruit. When he reached it, he found nothing but leaves, because it was not the season for figs. 14 Then he said to the tree, "May no one ever eat fruit from you again." And his disciples heard him say it. 15 On reaching Jerusalem, Jesus entered the temple courts and began driving out those who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves, 16 and would not allow anyone to carry merchandise through the temple courts.

17 And as he taught them, he said, "Is it not written: 'My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations?' But you have made it 'a den of robbers." 18 The chief priests and the teachers of the law heard this and began looking for a way to kill him, for they feared him, because the whole crowd was amazed at his teaching. 19 When evening came, Jesus and his disciples went out of the city. 20 In the morning, as they went along, they saw the fig tree withered from the roots. 21 Peter remembered and said to Jesus, "Rabbi, look! The fig tree you cursed has withered!" 22 "Have faith in God," Jesus answered. 23 "Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them. 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. 25 And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."


18 Early in the morning, as Jesus was on his way back to the city, he was hungry. 19 Seeing a fig tree by the road, he went up to it but found nothing on it except leaves. Then he said to it, "May you never bear fruit again!" Immediately the tree withered. 20 When the disciples saw this, they were amazed. "How did the fig tree wither so quickly?" they asked. 21 Jesus replied, "Truly I tell you, if you have faith and do not doubt, not only can you do what was done to the fig tree, but also you can say to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and it will be done. 22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."

MEANING OF THE FIG TREE PARABLE

Cursing the fig tree was Jesus' way of saying that the whole nation had become spiritually barren before the Lord. They had the form of religion but not the reality. They knew the right words to say, but their hearts were far from God.

According to Smith's Bible Dictionary, the fig tree was very common to the area both in Biblical times and still today. And it was common knowledge in Jesus' time that if you saw leaves on a fig tree, you could also expect fruit unless the tree was barren.

Throughout the <u>Bible</u> (<u>1 Kings 4:25</u>; <u>Micah 4:4</u>; <u>Zechariah 3:10</u>), sitting under their own fig tree was a common phrase symbolizing peace and prosperity.





CONSISTORY NEWS

In January of this year, work was completed on replacing all of the membraned roof surfaces on the Education Building, including the flat roofs over the kitchen and the office and the entire length of the front breezeway (Arcade). At the end of April, a new air conditioning/heat pump system was installed in the Fellowship Hall. The current air conditioning units were installed about 25 years ago and are no longer able to cool the Hall. The new units will be able to cool as well as heat the Hall. In cold weather, the oil furnace will no longer be used to heat the Hall thereby saving us the cost of oil for this part of the building. The new roofing and air conditioning/heat pump systems have resulted in a cost to the church of over \$50,000. To help Faith defray some of this cost, we would appreciate any extra financial help members and friends can provide for this huge but necessary undertaking.
